

REFERRAL FEE AGREEMENT

This Referral Fee Agreement (“Agreement”) is made as of the date below by and between the company named below, its successors, assigns, and affiliates (“Company”) and the referring party named below, its successors, assigns, and affiliates (“Referring Party”).

1. Services. Referring Party shall introduce the Company to the individual named below (“Agent”). No other services are required of the Referring Party. The Referring Party shall not engage in any negotiations whatsoever on behalf of the Company.
2. Referral Fee. If the Company accepts financing as a result of the Agent’s efforts on behalf of the Company, the Company hereby promises to pay the Referring Party, an amount equal to three percent (3%) of the said funds received by the Company, payable as the said funds are received by the Company. There is no requirement that the Company accept any financing arranged by the Agent. The Company does not owe any compensation to the Referring Party, unless the Company accepts financing arranged by the Agent upon such terms and conditions as agreed to by the Company in its sole discretion.
3. Limitation of Services. Referring Party is not a licensed securities dealer, and this Agreement is not intended for the purpose of buying, selling, or trading securities.
4. Relationship of Parties. The parties are independent contractors. No employment, partnership, or joint venture relationship is formed by this Agreement. The Referring Party shall not enter into any agreements on behalf of the Company.
5. Nonexclusive Rights. This Agreement does not grant to either party any exclusive rights to act on behalf of the other party.
6. Confidentiality. The Company agrees not to disclose the name of the Agent to any third party, except to the Company’s employees who have a need to know and the Company’s representatives, except as may be required by law.
7. Arbitration. In the event of any dispute regarding this Agreement, the parties agree to binding arbitration in Atlanta, Georgia under the rules of the American Arbitration Association. The parties agree to jurisdiction

and venue in Fulton County, State of Georgia, United States of America. The prevailing party shall be entitled to recover all reasonable attorney fees and costs of enforcing or collecting any judgment awarded.

8. Miscellaneous. This Agreement may only be amended by a written agreement signed by both parties. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia, United States of America.
